NEW HAMPSHIRE TURNOUT BOOSTS MONROE COUNTY DEMOCRATS

Monroe County Democratic Party Chair Steven Williams said Wednesday, “Democratic turnout in Tuesday’s New Hampshire’s primary was applauded by Monroe County Democrats as evidence of the Party’s surging strength throughout the nation.”

“Over 280,000 Democrats turned out to vote in New Hampshire, compared to 220,000 Republicans,” said Williams, “Fifty-six percent of the voters supported Democratic candidates.”

Even more encouraging, he said, were the exit polls which indicated that sixty percent of the state’s registered independents chose to vote Democratic.

“It is clear that Democrats have the momentum. That enthusiasm is spreading across the nation,” said Williams, “and regardless of who is the Democratic nominee Monroe County Democrats will be united in support.”

Discussion of the February 19 Wisconsin primary will be on the agenda at the Party’s monthly meeting at 7 p.m. Monday, January 14, at Tomah’s Cranberry Country Lodge.
